



# Barclay Butera

his year is turning out to be a spectacular one for Newport Beach-based designer Barclay Butera. In the summer, Butera joined an exclusive coterie of top stylesetters – luminaries that include Kelly Wearstler, Jonathan Adler and the granddaddy of them all, Philippe Starck – who have designed or renovated the interiors of hotels and resorts. L'Auberge del Mar, less than an hour's drive south from Orange County, debuted a posh but super-comfy beach makeover by Butera.

It's a look he knows all too well, as the designer's own home in Newport Beach is ocean-influenced.

In August, he introduced a line of scented candles that draws inspiration from the locations of his previous homes, such as Park City and Los Angeles.

This month, he launches his first coffeetable book by Assouline, *Barclay Butera: Living in Style*, a compilation of his best work. Here, Butera talks to *Coast* about what it's like to truly live in style.

#### Aesthetic sensibility of the home

Casual elegance and indoor/outdoor living. I love to be able to open the French doors from the

great room and the dining room and create the ultimate beach community experience.
